WEEK 1 — THE POWER OF HIS RESURRECTION

Understanding God's Greatest Demonstration of Power

Teaching Focus

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the greatest demonstration of God's power in history.

Creation revealed God's wisdom.

Miracles revealed God's compassion.

But the resurrection revealed **God's greatest power.**

Ephesians 1:19–20

"And what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe... which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead..."

The resurrection defeated:

- Death
- Sin
- Satan

- Fear

The apostles made the resurrection the center of their message.

Acts 4:33

"And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all."

The resurrection releases:

- Power
- Grace
- Authority

This week emphasizes:

- Understanding resurrection power
- Believing resurrection power
- Walking in resurrection power

Emphasis

- Resurrection is the greatest display of divine power
- The believer shares in resurrection power
- Resurrection power breaks impossibilities

WEEK 2 — RESURRECTION LIFE IN THE BELIEVER

Living the Life of the Risen Christ

Teaching Focus

The resurrection of Jesus introduced a new life for believers.

Because Christ rose, we now live resurrection life.

Romans 6:4

"...even so we also should walk in newness of life."

Resurrection life produces:

- Victory
- Freedom
- Transformation
- New beginnings

Colossians 3:1

"If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above..."

This week emphasizes:

- Living in victory
- Walking in newness
- Experiencing transformation

Emphasis

- Resurrection life is the believer's reality
- Victory flows from resurrection life
- Transformation follows resurrection life

Declaration

I walk in resurrection life.

I live in victory.

New life is working in me.

WEEK 3 — RESURRECTION POWER AT WORK

Restoration, Revival & Recovery

Teaching Focus

Resurrection power restores what was lost.

When Jesus rose, the disciples were revived and hope returned.

Joel 2:25

"So I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten..."

Resurrection power:

- Restores
- Revives
- Renews
- Recovers

This week emphasizes:

- Restoration
- Revival
- Recovery
- Renewal

Emphasis

- Resurrection restores lost things
- Revival follows resurrection power
- Recovery is part of resurrection life

Declaration

Restoration is my portion.

Revival begins in me.

Lost things are restored.

WEEK 4 — RESURRECTION HARVEST

Entering Manifestation & Testimonies

Teaching Focus

The resurrection of Jesus produced harvest.

Jesus became the firstfruit.

1 Corinthians 15:20

"But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits..."

Resurrection produces:

- Harvest
- Manifestation
- Testimonies
- Results

This week emphasizes:

- Harvest
- Manifestation
- Testimonies
- Results

Galatians 6:9

"And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap..."

Emphasis

- Resurrection produces harvest
- Harvest follows resurrection
- Manifestation is expected

Declaration

My harvest appears.

My season has come.

I walk in testimonies.

THEOLOGICAL FOUNDATION

Understanding Resurrection in Scripture

1. The Centrality of the Resurrection

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the foundation of Christianity.

Without the resurrection, the gospel has no power and faith has no meaning.

1 Corinthians 15:14

"And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty."

The resurrection confirms:

- Jesus is Lord
- Sin is defeated
- Death is conquered
- Salvation is secured

Christianity is not built on teachings alone — it is built on the resurrection.

The apostles emphasized the resurrection as the core of their message.

Acts 2:32

"This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses."

The resurrection is not just historical — it is foundational.

2. The Power of the Resurrection

The resurrection is the greatest demonstration of God's power.

Ephesians 1:19–20

"And what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe... which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead..."

This power:

- Defeated death
- Defeated Satan
- Broke limitations
- Established victory

This same resurrection power now works in believers.

Romans 8:11

"But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you... He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies..."

Resurrection power is now **available to believers**.

3. Resurrection Life in the Believer

The resurrection did not only raise Jesus — it introduced a new life for believers.

Romans 6:4

"...just as Christ was raised from the dead... even so we also should walk in newness of life."

Resurrection life means:

- New identity
- New strength
- New victory
- New beginnings

Believers are called to live in resurrection reality.

Colossians 3:1

"If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above..."

Resurrection life is not future — it is present.

4. The Resurrection Pattern in Scripture

Resurrection is a consistent pattern in Scripture.

God brings life out of death.

Examples:

- Abraham and Sarah (Romans 4:19–21)
- Dry bones (Ezekiel 37)
- Lazarus (John 11)
- Jesus (Matthew 28)

God specializes in resurrection.

Resurrection is God's method of restoration.

5. Resurrection and Harvest

Resurrection leads to harvest.

Jesus Himself revealed this principle.

John 12:24

"Unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies... it produces much grain."

Death → Resurrection → Harvest

Jesus became the firstfruit of resurrection harvest.

1 Corinthians 15:20

"But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits..."

Resurrection produces:

- Harvest
- Increase
- Multiplication

6. What Blocks Resurrection Manifestation

Some things resist resurrection manifestation:

- ✗ Unbelief
- ✗ Fear
- ✗ Discouragement

✘ Doubt

✘ Negative thinking

Faith activates resurrection reality.

Mark 9:23

"If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

7. Why April Is Important for ASK Global
