INTRODUCTION

February 2026 — Our Month of the Rain of the Spirit

After sowing seeds of sacrifice in January, February was appointed as the season of divine watering.

Seeds do not grow by effort alone — they grow by rain.

February emphasized:

- Dependence, not striving
- Receiving, not forcing
- Alignment, not pressure

It was a month of trusting the Holy Spirit to water what sacrifice prepared.

WEEK 1 — PREPARING THE GROUND

Positioned for the Rain

Teaching Focus

Rain does not fall on hardened ground.

Humility and repentance precede outpouring.

Hosea 10:12 (NKJV)

James 4:6–8 (NIV)

Emphasis

- January broke the ground
- February softened the heart
- Pride resists rain
- Humility attracts grace

Prepared hearts receive rain easily.

Declaration

My heart is ready.

My ground is prepared.

I am positioned for the rain.

WEEK 2 — ASKING FOR THE RAIN

Dependence, Prayer & Expectation

Teaching Focus

Rain is promised, but it is requested.

Zechariah 10:1 (NKJV)

Luke 11:13 (NIV)

Emphasis

- God responds to hunger
- Asking is faith, not desperation
- Trust precedes receiving

Those who ask, receive rain.

Declaration

As we ask, we receive.

The rain is falling.

We are refreshed.

WEEK 3 — THE EFFECT OF THE RAIN

Revival, Growth & Empowerment

Teaching Focus

Rain always produces evidence.

Isaiah 44:3–4 (NIV)

Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

Emphasis

- Weakness gives way to strength
- Revival begins inwardly
- Growth becomes visible

If rain falls, fruit must appear.

Declaration

The rain produces fruit.

I am empowered.

Growth is evident.

WEEK 4 – SUSTAINING THE FLOW

Walking in the Spirit

Teaching Focus

Rain must be retained, not wasted.

Galatians 5:16 (NKJV)

Ephesians 5:18 (NIV)

Emphasis

- The Spirit is a Person
- Outpouring becomes lifestyle
- Obedience preserves flow

We walk with the Spirit.

Declaration

I walk in the Spirit.

I remain filled.

The rain abides with me.

THEOLOGICAL FOUNDATION

Understanding the Rain of the Spirit

1. Meaning of the Rain of the Spirit

Rain represents divine supply that brings life and fruitfulness.

Without rain → dryness

With rain → life

Spiritually:

Without the Spirit → burnout

With the Spirit → power and fruit

Hosea 6:3 (NIV)

Rain is God's presence released.

2. Former and Latter Rain

Joel 2:23

Former Rain

- Begins growth
- Early encounters
- Spiritual awakening

Latter Rain

- Matures harvest
- Releases authority
- Produces fullness

February positioned ASK for latter-rain dimensions.

3. Spiritual Benefits of the Rain

1. Refreshment

Isaiah 44:3

Joy and hunger restored.

2. Revival

Habakkuk 3:2

Dormant gifts awakened.

3. Growth

Deuteronomy 11:14

Stability and depth.

4. Empowerment

Acts 1:8

Boldness and authority.

5. Fruitfulness

Isaiah 44:4

Lives and ministries multiply.

6. Healing

Hosea 14:5

Restoration of damaged areas.

7. Direction

Acts 13:2

Clarity and strategy.

8. Unity

Psalms 133:3

Love and cooperation.

9. Acceleration

Zechariah 10:1

Sudden breakthroughs.

4. Effects of the Rain on God's People

When rain falls consistently:

- ✓ Spirit-led lives (Romans 8:14)
- ✓ Powerful prayer (James 5:16–18)
- ✓ Deep worship (John 4:24)
- ✓ Effective ministry (1 Corinthians 2:4)
- ✓ Visible testimonies (Psalm 65:9–13)

5. What Blocks the Rain

- ✗ Pride — James 4:6
- ✗ Sin — Isaiah 59:1–2
- ✗ Disunity — Psalm 133
- ✗ Self-reliance — Zechariah 4:6
- ✗ Prayerlessness — Luke 18:1

Hence, the importance of preparation.

6. Positioning for Continuous Rain

Acts 2:42

- Humility
- Prayer
- Obedience
- Hunger
- Unity
- Consistency

These sustain outpouring.

7. Why God Emphasized Rain for ASK

Because ASK was entering:

- International expansion
- Leadership multiplication
- Wider responsibility

Rain was needed to:

- ✓ Prevent burnout
- ✓ Preserve vision
- ✓ Sustain prayer culture
- ✓ Maintain spiritual life
