INTRODUCTION

January 2026 — Our Month of Sacrifice

As we stepped into 2026 — our Year of Wholeness — God intentionally ordered our first steps. January was not a random beginning; it was a foundational month.

Sacrifice — The Language of Alignment

1. Biblical Definition of Sacrifice

Sacrifice is intentional surrender to God for alignment and obedience.

Genesis 22:12

Matthew 16:24

Sacrifice answers one question:

“Who comes first?”

2. Sacrifice Throughout Scripture

Genesis 4:3–5

Hebrews 11:4

Sacrifice existed before law and priesthood.

It is faith expressed tangibly.

3. Types of Sacrificial Expressions in Scripture

Type 1: Sacrifice of Life & Self

Romans 12:1

Total surrender and yielded living.

Type 2: Sacrifice of Praise & Worship

Hebrews 13:15

Psalms 34:1

Praising God in pressure and waiting.

Type 3: Sacrifice of Giving

Hebrews 13:16

2 Samuel 24:24

Giving that stretches faith and trust.

Type 4: Sacrifice of Obedience

1 Samuel 15:22

Alignment over convenience.

Type 5: Sacrifice of Fasting & Waiting

Joel 2:12

Surrender of appetite and control.

Type 6: Sacrifice of Forgiveness & Relationships

Matthew 5:23-24

Letting go of offense and bitterness.

Type 7: Sacrifice of Self-Will & Ambition

Luke 22:42

Yielding personal agendas to God.

4. The Fruit of Sacrifice

John 12:24

Sacrifice produces:

- Multiplication
- Restoration
- Connection
- Spiritual fruitfulness

Wholeness is the harvest of consecration.

5. Practical Teaching Guidelines

Leaders emphasized:

- ✓ Sacrifice is Spirit-led
- ✓ Sacrifice is seasonal
- ✓ Sacrifice brings peace
- ✓ No comparison
- ✓ No pressure
- ✓ No performance

“We are not competing in sacrifice.
We are responding to God.”
