WEEK 1 — HEARING GOD'S VOICE

Receiving Before Releasing

Teaching Focus

Prophecy begins with hearing.

You cannot speak for God if you do not hear God.

John 10:27

“My sheep hear My voice...”

Hearing requires:

- Stillness
- Purity
- Time
- Sensitivity
- Obedience

Noise blocks revelation.

Distraction distorts clarity.

Before God uses your mouth, He trains your ears.

Emphasis

- Revelation precedes declaration
- Sensitivity precedes authority
- Listening precedes releasing

Declaration

I hear God clearly.

My spirit is sensitive.

I receive divine direction.

WEEK 2 — SPEAKING GOD'S WORD

Declaring His Mind

Teaching Focus

After hearing comes speaking.

Faith is not complete until spoken.

Romans 4:17

“Calls those things which do not exist as though they did...”

God expects agreement from our mouth.

Words shape atmosphere.

Speech releases authority.

Negative confession weakens faith.

Prophetic confession activates power.

You do not describe problems.

You declare God's mind.

Emphasis

- The mouth carries authority
- Words establish spiritual direction
- Agreement activates manifestation

Declaration

My mouth carries authority.

I speak God's Word.

My declarations stand.

WEEK 3 — CREATIVE & HEALING PROPHECY

Releasing Resurrection Power

Teaching Focus

Prophecy restores what was broken.

Jesus healed with words.

Dry bones lived by words.

John 11:43

“Lazarus, come forth!”

Words empowered by the Spirit carry resurrection force.

This week emphasized:

- Healing
- Restoration
- Renewal
- Revival

Believers were trained to speak life over:

- Families
- Bodies
- Finances

- Destinies
- Nations

Emphasis

- Resurrection follows revelation
- The Word carries creative power
- Restoration is activated by agreement

Declaration

Resurrection power flows through me.

Healing and restoration follow me.

WEEK 4 — PROPHETIC HARVEST

Calling Forth Results

Teaching Focus

Prophecy must end in manifestation.

Seed + Rain + Word = Harvest.

Galatians 6:9

“Let us not grow weary...”

Prophetic partnership requires:

- Persistence
- Patience
- Consistency
- Thanksgiving

Many speak but stop early.

Many declare but grow discouraged.

Prophetic maturity continues speaking until results appear.

Emphasis

- Faith sustains declaration
- Agreement must remain consistent
- Harvest responds to persistent belief

Declaration

My harvest appears.

My labor is rewarded.

God’s Word is fulfilled.

THEOLOGICAL FOUNDATION

Understanding Prophecy in Scripture

1. What Prophecy Is

Prophecy is divine communication expressed through human cooperation.

It is:

- Hearing from God
- Speaking in agreement
- Releasing heaven's intention

1 Corinthians 14:3

"He who prophesies speaks edification, exhortation, and comfort."

Prophecy builds.

It does not destroy.

2. What Prophecy Is Not

- It is not emotional hype
- It is not manipulation

- It is not self-exaltation
- It is not fortune-telling

True prophecy flows from intimacy and Scripture.

3. Creative Power of Words

Proverbs 18:21

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue...”

Hebrews 11:3

“The worlds were framed by the word of God...”

God created through speech.

We participate through agreement.

4. The Prophetic Pattern in Scripture

Abraham — Called things not seen (Romans 4:17)

Ezekiel — Spoke to dry bones (Ezekiel 37)

Jesus — Spoke to storms, sickness, death

Apostles — Spoke healing and boldness

Prophecy is consistent throughout Scripture.

5. The Relationship Between Rain and Prophecy

January: Seed

February: Rain

March: Word

Rain empowers the mouth.

Without the Spirit, speech is empty.

With the Spirit, words carry force.

6. What Blocks Prophetic Authority

✘ Doubt

✘ Fear

✘ Double-mindedness

✘ Negative confession

✘ Unbelief

Faith strengthens prophetic impact.

7. Why March Was Necessary for ASK

ASK was entering:

- International expansion
- Leadership multiplication
- Greater responsibility

Prophetic maturity prevents passivity.

We do not wait for life to happen.

We participate with God in shaping it.
